Here in Mongolia, summer is past and fall has begun. We are already having night time temperatures down in the low 30's and it will not be long before we see freezing weather. Eliza and Esther started school in August and Lydia and I will begin language school this month. I will be taking one class a week and Lydia two classes. We appreciate your prayers as we strive to learn the Mongolian language.

Please continue to pray for the First Bible, Mongolia printing ministry. Jeff Kruchkow will be here most of September holding refresher training on the printing press and related equipment. During this time, we are planning on printing The Big Tract. The Big Tract is a gospel coloring book tract written by Don Weeks, BIMi missionary to Bolivia.

Please pray for Bayanmunkh. It has been a couple

of months since we have been able to have Bible study with him due to his schedule. He called me last week and asked if we could resume Bible study in mid—September. Please pray that he would make Bible Study a priority in his life.

In our last letter, we asked you to pray for Daskha and his wife Tungaa. You will remember that Tungaa was recently diagnosed with stomach cancer. They removed her entire stomach, but found that the cancer had spread to her lymphatic system. She has begun chemotherapy. Please keep this family in your prayers. Please pray specifically for Tungaa's salvation.
